

VOCATIONAL PROGRAMS

Camden-Frontier vocationally bound students have many opportunities for preparation in a field of their interest. There are various courses through the Hillsdale County Intermediate School District or other nearby schools (shared-time programs). The student's Educational Development Plan must reflect an interest in the career path chosen.

HILLSDALE COUNTY INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT PROGRAMS – The HCISD is offering several programs for the 2007-2008 school year. These programs, beginning the junior year, are intended to help meet the vocational needs of some students and also to respond to the requests from area businesses to develop more skilled workers in these career fields. A student may earn three credits per year (1.5 credits per semester) by attending the half-day program. **Students must provide their own transportation.**
