School Day: School will begin at **7:50 a.m.** Dismissal will be at **2:50**

Breakfast/Lunch: The breakfast program is free to all students K – 12. Lunch for students in K – 6th grade is \$2.35/day, M.S./ H.S. lunch is \$2.60/day. Milk is 60¢. Enclosed you will find a Free and Reduced lunch form. **The Free and Reduced Lunch program provides funding for our school, so we encourage all families to fill out the form regardless of whether you qualify or not.** In the past, many have families qualified, but did not complete the form to receive the benefit. The district uses a computerized debit card system, so student's identity is kept private.

Bus Routes: Please remember that pickup and drop off times may change slightly due to changes in enrollment. Please be prepared for early/late pickup and drop off the first week of school until bus routes can be established. If there are questions on transportation services, please contact Paul Truax, Transportation Supervisor at 517-368-5891 after August 12, 2019. If you will be transporting your child(ren) to/from school we would like to remind you to **please use the parent parking lot located by the portable west of the school building. Please remember that you will not be allowed to use the circle drive in front of the school building when buses are present in the drive.**
